## Game \#18: January 29, 2009, 7 p.m. CST <br> Valparaiso (9-8, 4-3 Horizon) at Milwaukee (8-10, 3-4 Horizon) Klotsche Center $(5,000)$ - Milwaukee, Wis.

Coming Up in Crusader Hoops: After having its three-game winning streak snapped on Friday evening at Butler, the Valparaiso Crusaders will look to rebound and return to winning ways on Thursday night when the Brown and Gold travels to Milwaukee. Valpo is in the midst of a three-game road trip and currently tied for fourth place in the Horizon League standings.

On the Air: Thursday's game against Milwaukee will be carried live on the Horizon League Network at horizonleaguenetwork.tv or through the link at valpoathletics.com. In addition, the game can be heard live on WVUR (95.1-FM, Valparaiso) and through the Valpo athletics website. Adam Amin and Danny Robertson will call all of the action live from the Klotsche Center. The game will also be shown live on Time Warner Sports 32 in the Milwaukee area. Live stats are also available via Gametracker through valpoathletics.com.

Series Notes: Milwaukee leads the all-time series against Valpo 8-2 and hold a 5-1 advantage in Wisconsin. Last season the Panthers won all three meetings between the two schools. During the regular season Milwaukee was a 68-62 victor at the ARC before posting a 76-70 triumph in Milwaukee. The Panthers also downed the Crusaders 67-60 in Milwaukee in the quarterfinals of the Horizon League Tournament. The Crusaders' last win in the series came in Valpo, 61-57, back in 2001.

Wrapping Up Butler: Susan Lester scored 27 of her game-high 31 points in the first half as the Bulldogs defeated Valpo 77-44 on Friday evening in Indianapolis, Ind. Butler opened up a 48-19 lead at halftime after shooting 70.4\% from the floor in the opening 20 minutes and Valpo could never recover. Betsy Adams made four three-pointers to lead the Crusaders with 12 points.

Scouting Milwaukee: The Panthers have won two of their last three games following an 83-74 victory on the road at Loyola last Saturday afternoon. Milwaukee tied an NCAA record making 26-of-26 from the free throw line in the win. Traci Edwards is second the Horizon League in scoring averaging 17.7 points per game while ranking third in rebounding grabbing 8.1 boards per night. Lindsay Laur is the team's second leading scorer with 8.3 points per game. As a team the Panthers lead the league making 6.2 threes per game and dishing out 14.7 assists.

Adams For Three: Betsy Adams went 4-for-5 from three-point range on Friday evening against Butler to score a team-leading 12 points for the Crusaders. The four triples marked a new career high for the freshman, with the 12 points being just two shy of her season's best. Adams has stepped up in Horizon League play this year, averaging 7.3 points per game against conference foes. She is shooting $38.7 \%$ from long range in league play as well while averaging just over 16 minutes per contest.

Welcome Back Lauren: Lauren Kenney returned to the Crusader lineup for the first time on Friday at Butler since missing six games with an ankle injury. She was 2-for-2 from the floor and added a rebound and a steal in eight minutes of action. On the season, the junior leads Valpo in both scoring ( 12.0 points per game) and rebounding ( 7.7 boards per night) while shooting $51.6 \%$ from the floor.

Farris Crashes the Glass: Whitney Farris has been getting to the glass over the last eight games. The junior forward has grabbed six or more rebounds in five of the eight contests, while grabbing a team-leading five on Friday at Butler. Farris is averaging 4.9 boards per game this season, but leads the team with 5.3 rebounds in Horizon League action.

Forcing Turnovers in League Play: Valpo is forcing opponents into 21.3 turnovers per contest in conference play this season. The Crusaders forced 26 miscues from Loyola on Saturday, and have also created 27 and 31 takeaways against Cleveland State and Wright State. Valpo is +4.6 in turnover margin against Horizon League foes this season.

Emig Has Solid Outing: Having moved into the starting lineup for the last four games, Katie Emig has started to become more of an offensive producer. The redshirt-sophomore scored nine points, including making a career-high 5-of-6 free throws, against butler. She added a sea-son-high 14 points against UIC two games ago, and is averaging 7.8 points per game since moving into the starting lineup. Emig also played a career-high 29 minutes against the Bulldogs on Friday.

Who Is Going to Do the Scoring Tonight?: Eight different Crusaders have led the Brown and Gold in scoring this season. Agnieszka Kulaga is the team-leader with six high scoring contests, while Launa Hochstetler has led the team on four other nights.

Among the Nation's Best at the Free Throw Line: Agnieszka Kulaga and Launa Hochstetler rank 13th and 24th respectively in all of NCAA Division I at the free throw line this season. Kulaga also leads the Horizon League shooting $88.5 \%$ (46-of-52) from the line. For her career, the senior is an $83.1 \%$ shooter from the charity stripe and just reached the 225 career attempt mark to qualify to become Valpo's career percentage leader. Hochstetler is shooting $84.7 \%$ for her career, but still needs nine more attempts to move to the top of the all-time charts.

Valpo Makes More Free Throws Than League Opponents Attempt: Valpo has made 98 free throws this season in Horizon League action. The Crusaders have made 17 more free throws than conference foes have even attempted during these games. On the season as a whole, the Crusaders lead the conference shooting $74.3 \%$ from the charity stripe.

League's Leading Offense: Valpo leads the Horizon League scoring 64.6 points per game on the season. The Crusaders have three of the top-20 scorers in the league, led by Aimee Litka who is eighth with 11.8 points per night. The team's leading scorer, Lauren Kenney (12.0 ppg) missed the six games with an injury and is not currently eligible for the league leaders.

Surpassing 300 Assists: Launa Hochstetler’s feed to Whitney Farris with 13:53 to play in the second half against Loyola made the senior just the sixth Crusader in school history to reach the 300 assist mark for a career. Hochstetler currently has 303 career assists and needs just 37 more helpers to move into the top-five all-time wearing the Brown and Gold.

Playing Overtime: Valparaiso's overtime win against Detroit was the Crusaders' fifth straight when playing extra sessions. The Crusaders have not dropped an overtime contest since November 21, 2005, a double-overtime affair against Bradley.

Kulaga Nearing Top-20 All-Time at Valpo in Scoring: Agnieszka Kulaga has the opportunity to move into the top20 all-time at Valpo in scoring within the next game or two. The senior guard has scored 818 career points, and needs just 12 more to match Jill Otto’s (1985-1989) 20th place mark of 830 points.

Freeman Reaches Several Milestones: Head coach Keith Freeman has reached three milestones already this season. Valpo’s victory against Florida State on November 29 was the 375th of his career overall coaching women’s basketball. He coached his 600th collegiate game at Wright State on January 8 and recorded his 250 th victory on the Crusader sidelines on January 10 against Detroit.

Kenney Sets School Record for Free Throws: Lauren Kenney's 13-for-13 free throw performance against Florida State in the championship is the best single game performance in school history. The junior bettered Lisa Diefenthaler's 1994 mark of 12-for-12 set against Western Illinois. Debbie Bolen made all 11 of her tosses in 1991 while three others have gone 10-for-10 in a game.

More Solid Free Throw Shooting: As a team, Valpo went 35-of-42 from the line against Florida State, with the 35 makes ranking second all-time in school history. The 42 attempts were tied for fifth most ever in a game, while Lauren Kenney’s 13 makes in the game tie for fifth on the individual charts.

Kulaga Nearing Top-15 in Assists: Agnieszka Kulaga had two assists against Loyola and now has 223 career assists to rank 16th all-time wearing the Brown and Gold. She is one assist shy of Stephanie Greer (1987-1991), who is 15th all-time with 224 career helpers and five behind Lina Mascarenas (1988-1992) and Betsy Rietema (2003-2007) for 13th place all-time.

Litka Among Top-10 All-Time in Triples: Aimee Litka made one more three-pointer against Loyola and has passed Heidi Diefenthaler (19921996) into seventh place all-time at Valpo for triples made in a career. Litka now has 142 treys in four seasons, and trails Megan Newcomer (1996-2000) by just three triples for sixth place all-time.

First Win Ever Against a Ranked Foe: The victory against Purdue was the first ever for a Crusader squad against a team ranked in the top25. Valpo has played three top-25 programs this season, going 1-2 in those games.

Smart Students as Well: Valpo has had three players named U.S. Army Scholar-Athletes of the Week by the Horizon League thus far this year. Agnieszka Kulaga earned the honor on December 19 while Launa Hochstetler captured the accolade one week later on December 26.

Hochstetler Honored by Horizon League: Launa Hochstetler was named the Horizon League Player of the Week on January 19 for the first time in her career after averaging 21 points, 3.5 rebounds, 4.0 assists, and 2.5 steals in victories over UIC and Loyola. The senior guard tied her career high with 24 points against UIC and added 18 points and six assists against the Ramblers. Hochstetler shot $57.1 \%$ from the floor, including 3-of-6 from three-point range, and made 7-of-8 free throws in the two games.

Kulaga Earns Two Honors: Agnieszka Kulaga was named the Horizon League’s Player of the Week as well as the Most Valuable Player at the Coors Rocky Mountain Invitational for her stellar play from November 25-29. The senior guard averaged 22 points per game and shot $58.3 \%$ for the week in three games while garnering her fourth career conference honor. She scored 20 points on 7 -of-11 shooting from the floor in the first game of the tournament against Colorado State, then added 22 points, including an 11-of-12 performance from the free throw line, in the championship against Florida State.

Litka Also Named to All-Tournament Team: Aimee Litka also was named to the All-Tournament Team at the Coors Rocky Mountain Invitational. She averaged 17 points and five rebounds per game in the event, including a 20-point effort in the championship against Florida State.

Valpo Captures Division I Tournament Title For First Time: Valpo’s win at the Coors Rocky Mountain Invitational was the first tournament title for the Brown and Gold in the Division I era. The last time the Crusaders captured a tourney title was at the Lady Redmen Classic hosted by Carthage in the 1985-1986 season as Valpo downed Lakeland, Carthage, and Clarke.

Kenney Named to Christmas City Classic All-Tournament Team: Lauren Kenney was named to the All-Tournament Team at the Christmas City Classic after averaging 14.5 points and 10.5 rebounds per game. Kenney had 22 points and 14 boards in the opener against La Salle.

Kulaga Earns Preseason Honors: Agnieszka Kulaga was named to the Preseason All-Horizon League Second Team after averaging 14.6 points and 5.2 rebounds per game last year for the Crusaders. She had a triple-double last season and earned Second Team All-League honors as a junior.

Valpo Adds Two for Next Year's Class: Head coach Keith Freeman has signed two players to National Letters of Intent for the 2009-2010 season. Skyler Gick is a 5'7" guard from Otterbein, Ind. who averaged 15.1 points per game as a junior at Benton Central High School. Laura Richards is a 5'9" guard from Connersville, Ind and averaged 16.0 points an 5.2 rebounds per game a year ago at Connersville High School.
