Don Meyer Northern State University
 Head Men's Coach
WINNINGEST NCAA COACH IN HISTORY (910-310)

- In his 10th season with Northern State, Meyer jumped ahead of Bobby Knight to hold the crown as the Winningest Coach in NCAA history
- On coaching, Coach Don Meyer believes, "Your program must have an overriding purpose which is clearly visible and which teaches lessons beyond winning."
- Meyer was the recipient of the Jimmy V Award for Perseverance at the 2009 ESPY awards

Vance Walberg University of Massachusetts
 Assistant Men's Coach

- Before accepting the position as UMass Assistant Coach, Walberg was the head coach at Pepperdine from 2006-2008 and has been coaching now for 30 years
- In 2003 & 2005 Walberg was named California Community College Coach of the Year as well as being named CVC Coach of the Year for four seasons
- Walberg is known for creating the dribble drive motion offense sometimes known as the Memphis Attack or the AASAA (Attack-Attack-Skip-Attack-Attack)
- His offense is the offense that led to success for John Calipari's Memphis Tigers

Kathi Bennett University of Wisconsin
 Assistant Women's Coach
Career Record: 296-177

- Bennett is the daughter of former University of Wisconsin Head Coach Dick Bennett and sister of Washington State's Tony Bennett
- During her five seasons at Indiana University, Bennett became the first coach in school history to defeat at least one nationally ranked opponent in each of her first three seasons
- Known for her pack defense which she defines as, "The pack is about getting back on every possession, allowing no easy shots, keeping the ball out of the lane, no easy penetration."

Keith Freeman

**Valparaiso University
Women's Head Coach
Career record 388-229**

- Freeman owns a 388-229 lifetime mark. The school's all-time winningest coach, he enters the 2009-2010 season with a record of 259-182 at Valpo.
- He has led the Crusaders to back to back NCAA appearances, an Elite Eight WNIT appearance, 2 Mid-Con regular season titles, 2 Mid-Con tournament titles and in 2002 recorded the biggest turn-around record in the nation. He has had five 20 win seasons and is nearing the 400 win plateau.
- During the 2008-2009 campaign, Freeman became the first coach in school history to lead his team to a victory over ranked Purdue. He also won the Coors Rocky Mountain Invitational by defeating Florida State and Colorado State.
