Next Up in Crusader Basketball: The leading scorer in the Horizon League will be on display Thursday night when the Crusaders entertain the Detroit Titans at the Athletics-Recreation Center in a 7:05 pm jump ball. Senee Shearer is averaging 21.1 points per game and has amassed a league-high 56 three-pointers. Detroit is in search of its first road win while the Brown and Gold vie for their first home victory.

Last Time Out: The Crusaders shot 15-of-25 (60%) in the first half, but they shot 5-of-30 (16.7%) in the second half as the UIC Flames claimed a 69-51 win in Chicago. Valpo's last field goal of the game came with 9:08 on the clock and was then followed by 14 straight missed shots from the floor. A Charae Richardson free-throw in the waning seconds of the game ended a nearly eight-minute scoring drought. UIC senior Katie Hannemann was pulled after being whistled for her third foul with just under seven minutes left in the first half. She returned in the second half to score 14 of her game-high 18 points.

Head Coach Tracey Dorow: Tracey Dorow (13-35) is in her second season at the helm of the Valparaiso women's basketball program in 2013-14. In her first season, Dorow led the Crusaders to eleven victories overall, including five in Horizon League play. Dorow arrived in Valparaiso after 14 seasons at Ferris State. She compiled a 232-163 record while with the Bulldogs. Furthermore, Ferris State posted the #1 grade point average in all of Division II for the 1999-2000 women's basketball season as well as the #2 ranking in 2002-2003.

Storylines...

- Both teams are searching for their first Horizon League win of the season.

- Detroit's Senee Shearer leads the league in 3-pointers made (56) and is on a streak of three straight 20+ point contests.

- Shearer has made 13 threes in six career games versus Valpo.

- Jessi Wiedemann was 7-for-11 field goal shooting in the season series against Detroit last year.

- Valpo and Detroit are ranked 8th and 9th, respectively, in scoring defense.

- The Crusaders and Titans split the 2012-13 season series with each team winning at home.

- After finishing the regular season with a 17-13 record, Detroit was crowned WBI champions after victories over Belmont, College of Charleston, Penn and McNeese State.

- Ellisha Crosby has shined in the shadows of Shearer: the junior is averaging 17.5 points and 7.4 rebounds per game for @Detroit_Titans.

- The @Detroit_Titans are just a 64.7% free-throw shooting team. - Shearer's 21.1 PPG average is 24th in the nation. Her 3.29 threepoint field goals per game ranks 4th.

- Opponents hold a 59-25 advantage in blocks over @Detroit_Titans.

- Autumn Rademacher is in her sixth season as head coach of the Titans.

- Rademacher graduated from Detroit where she is the third-leading scorer in school history.

- Rademacher spent time as an assistant coach at Green Bay and Western Michigan before returning to Detroit.

Jessica Carr

- Gave out a career-high six assists at UIC on Tuesday night.

- Got back in double figures Saturday for first time in four games.

- Scored 12 points and had four assists in just her second game of the season.

- Made her season debut versus Western Michigan on Dec. 29th, where she scored five points and notched an assist, steal, and rebound.

Elizabeth Hamlet

- Scored a season-high 12 points versus her alma mater (Oakland) on Jan. 15. - Shot 3-for-5 from the field in Valpo's 63-61 defeat of Toledo at the Toledo Invite.

Abby Dean

- Leads the Horizon League in free-throw percentage (89.7%).

- Has knocked down five field goals in six different contests.
- Has compiled 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, and 17-point games this season.
- Has started every game for the Crusaders.
- Registered a career-high 17 points at Tennessee Tech on 11/24/13.
- Scored first collegiate points at Cameron Indoor Stadium on 11/23/12.
- Made collegiate debut on November 14th versus Purdue-Calumet.
- Tossed in 11 points in 19 minutes vs.Western Michigan last season.

Lexi Miller

- Tallied 13 assists to five turnovers during the Toledo Invite.
- Scored a career-high 18 points vs. Tennessee Tech on 11/24/13.
- Owns best assists/turnover ratio of any Crusader (32:30).
- Accumulated 15 points, four rebounds, four assists, and three steals (all career highs at the time) at Saint Louis on 11/10/13.
- Made collegiate debut against the Indiana Hoosiers 11/9/12.

Charae Richardson

Sharon Karungi

- Shot a season-best 80% (8-10) from the floor Saturday vs. WSU.

Tracey Dorow Head Coach 2nd Season 245-198 overall, 13-35 at Valpo Western Michigan, 1996

Tracey Dorow was named head coach of the Valparaiso women's basketball program in April of 2012.

Dorow arrived at Valpo after spending 14 seasons as the head coach at Ferris State University, guiding the Bulldogs to four NCAA Division II Tournament appearances, two Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) North Division championships, and four 20-win seasons.

In her 14 seasons at Ferris State, Dorow compiled a 232-163 (.587) record, including a 23-7 mark in 2011-2012 while guiding the Bulldogs to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. The all-time winningest coach in FSU history, she led her squad to the Sweet Sixteen in 2007.

The GLIAC Coach of the Year in 2003-2004, Dorow had five players earn a total of seven All-American honors and had seven players tally 10 total All-Region Team accolades. Her student-athletes earned All-GLIAC honors 22 times and 10 times she had players represented on the GLIAC All-Defensive Team. Under Dorow's guidance, Ferris State produced the GLIAC Player of the Year in 2000-2001, and she twice coached the GLIAC Freshman of the Year.

Dorow's student-athletes also excelled in the classroom, as three times she has led a First Team Academic All-American and 14 times her players have earned Academic All-District honors. A total of 45 different players earned GLIAC All-Academic recognition during her time at Ferris State. Ferris State posted the No. 1 grade point average in the country in Division II for the 1999-2000 women's basketball season, and her team ranked second in the nation in 2002-2003.

Dorow began her coaching career as an assistant coach at Lake Michigan Community College in Benton Harbor, Mich. where she helped lead the Indians to a 69-22 record in three seasons, winning two Western Collegiate Conference titles. Lake Michigan finished fourth in the 1997 NJCAA national tournament and held a No. 1 national ranking in February of that same season. She also spent one season as a graduate assistant at the University of Indianapolis.

A collegiate player at Illinois State from 1990-1993, she led the Redbirds in assists as a sophomore while finishing seventh in the Gateway Conference that same season. After transferring to Northern Michigan University for the 1993-1994 season, she earned Newcomer of the Year and Best Defensive Player honors for the Wildcats. Dorow had 131 assists and made 54 threes at NMU in her one season there. As a prep player, she finished third in the state of Michigan for Miss Basketball in 1990 and was named to the Detroit Free Press All-Decade Team.

Dorow earned her Bachelor of Science degree in education from Western Michigan University in 1996 and her Master of Arts degree from the University of Indianapolis in 2003 in curriculum and instruction. She married her husband, Rob, in August of 2007. The Dorow's have two children: Lainie, 4, and Baxter, 2, who are both incredibly proud to be Crusaders.
