Next Up in Crusader Basketball: Valparaiso concludes a three-game road swing to open the 2013-14 season Saturday afternoon as the Crusaders face Notre Dame at Purcell Pavilion at a 1:00 p.m. tip. Saturday's game represents the third top-10 team that Valpo has faced in the past calendar year (#4 Duke and #8 Louisville last year).

Last Time Out: Illinois' full-court pressure eventually caught up to the Crusaders as they committed 27 turnovers in an 87-59 loss at State Farm Center Tuesday night in Champaign. Sharon Karungi had a monster game for Valpo, scoring 15 points and grabbing 12 rebounds en route to her first double-double for the Brown and Gold. Abby Dean tossed in a career-high 13 points on 5-of-12 shooting. Head coach Tracey Dorow has rewarded the sophomore with enhanced playing time and Dean has capitalized. Charae Richardson scored 10 points to be one of only two Crusaders to record double-digit points in each of the first two contests thus far. Valpo trailed 47-24 at half, but were only outscored 40-35 in the second half. Amber Moore led the scoring attack for the Fighting Illini as she dropped in 23 points.

Head Coach Tracey Dorow: Tracey Dorow (11-22) is in her second season at the helm of the Valparaiso women's basketball program in 2013-14. In her first season, Dorow led the Crusaders to eleven victories overall, including five in Horizon League play. Dorow arrived in Valparaiso after 14 seasons at Ferris State. She compiled a 232-163 record while with the Bulldogs. Furthermore, Ferris State posted the #1 grade point average in all of Division II for the 1999-2000 women's basketball season as well as the #2 ranking in 2002-2003.

Series Notes: Notre Dame has never lost to Valparaiso in women's basketball. The Fighting Irish have won all 24 meetings between the two teams in a series that started in 1977-78. The last time Notre Dame and Valpo met on the hard-

Storylines...

- This is Valpo's first game inside Purcell Pavilion since Dec. 12th, 2009.
- The trip to Notre Dame is the final one before the Crusaders play their home opener next Thursday against IUPUI.
- Because of injuries to four players, Valpo will be dressing eight players Saturday afternoon.
- Valpo comes to town as the Fighting Irish induct Skylar Diggins into Notre Dame's Ring of Honor.
- Irish guard Jewell Loyd is the sister of former Crusader basketball player and 2008 grad Jarryd Loyd.
- Valpo is in a three-game part of the schedule where it faces an A-10 team, a Big Ten team, and a Big East team.
- Notre Dame's senior class has lost just 14 games in its four years.
- A win Saturday would be the first over Notre Dame in 25 attempts.

Head Coach

2nd Season

Western Michigan, 1996

Tracey Dorow was named head coach of the Valparaiso women's basketball program in April of 2012.

Dorow arrived at Valpo after spending 14 seasons as the head coach at Ferris State University, guiding the Bulldogs to four NCAA Division II Tournament appearances, two Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) North Division championships, and four 20-win seasons.

In her 14 seasons at Ferris State, Dorow compiled a 232-163 (.587) record, including a 23-7 mark in 2011-2012 while guiding the Bulldogs to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. The all-time winningest coach in FSU history, she led her squad to the Sweet Sixteen in 2007.

The GLIAC Coach of the Year in 2003-2004, Dorow had five players earn a total of seven All-American honors and had seven players tally 10 total All-Region Team accolades. Her student-athletes earned All-GLIAC honors 22 times and 10 times she had players represented on the GLIAC All-Defensive Team. Under Dorow's guidance, Ferris State produced the GLIAC Player of the Year in 2000-2001, and she twice coached the GLIAC Freshman of the Year.

Dorow's student-athletes also excelled in the classroom, as three times she has led a First Team Academic All-American and 14 times her players have earned Academic All-District honors. A total of 45 different players earned GLIAC All-Academic recognition during her time at Ferris State. Ferris State posted the No. 1 grade point average in the country in Division II for the 1999-2000 women's basketball season, and her team ranked second in the nation in 2002-2003.

Dorow began her coaching career as an assistant coach at Lake Michigan Community College in Benton Harbor, Mich. where she helped lead the Indians to a 69-22 record in three seasons, winning two Western Collegiate Conference titles. Lake Michigan finished fourth in the 1997 NJCAA national tournament and held a No. 1 national ranking in February of that same season. She also spent one season as a graduate assistant at the University of Indianapolis.

A collegiate player at Illinois State from 1990-1993, she led the Redbirds in assists as a sophomore while finishing seventh in the Gateway Conference that same season. After transferring to Northern Michigan University for the 1993-1994 season, she earned Newcomer of the Year and Best Defensive Player honors for the Wildcats. Dorow had 131 assists and made 54 threes at NMU in her one season there. As a prep player, she finished third in the state of Michigan for Miss Basketball in 1990 and was named to the Detroit Free Press All-Decade Team.

Dorow earned her Bachelor of Science degree in education from Western Michigan University in 1996 and her Master of Arts degree from the University of Indianapolis in 2003 in curriculum and instruction. She married her husband, Rob, in August of 2007. The Dorow's have two children: Lainie, 4, and Baxter, 2, who are both incredibly proud to be Crusaders.

2012-2013: Saw action in 29 games with eight starts as a sophomore...averaged 4.1 points per game...went 22-for-25 from the free-throw line, good for the best FT percentage (88%) of any Crusader...her 34.4% from three-point land was also tops on the team for any player with more than five attempts...collected 55 assists on the season...logged three minutes in a win in the season opener over Indiana (Nov. 9)...played 20 minutes and dished out two assists in addition to knocking down a trey versus Purdue-Calumet (Nov. 14)...pulled down two boards and sunk a free throw at Butler (Nov. 19)...nailed a three-pointer and hauled in three rebounds in her first start of the season at Cameron Indoor Stadium versus #4 Duke (Nov. 23)...recorded an assist and a steal in a start at Western Illinois (Nov. 27)...made a three-pointer and had two assists at Louisville (Dec. 8)...went 2-for-3 from three-point land and recorded a steal at Michigan (Dec. 20)...tallied five points, five boards, and four assists in 27 minutes versus Youngstown State (Jan. 12)...scored nine points on 3-of-6 shooting versus Green Bay (Jan. 26)...converted on her only three-point attempt at Wright State as part of a five-point game (Jan. 31)...accumulated a season-high five assists against Cleveland State (Feb. 2)...was 2-for-2 from the field at Detroit (Feb. 9)...brought down six boards and went 6-for-6 from the charity stripe versus UIC (Feb. 16)...scored eight points and had four assists against Milwaukee (Feb. 21)...started the final six games of the season, averaging 7.5 points in those tilts...recorded a season-high 14 points versus UIC in the Horizon League Conference Tournament while logging a season-high 33 minutes (Mar. 11)...tallied eight points and five rebounds in the season finale at #20 Green Bay (Mar. 13).
