Next Up in Crusader Basketball: Valpo will get its first conference road test when it heads to Michigan to take on the Oakland Golden Grizzlies. The Crusaders and Oakland battled for eight seasons while the two schools resided in the Mid-Continent Conference from 2000-2007. The rivalry reignites Wednesday night at the Athletics Center O'Rena in Rochester.

Last Time Out: Youngstown State defeated the Crusaders 62-49 in the Horizon League opener for both teams. The Brown and Gold went nearly nine minutes without scoring while the Penguins extended their second half lead to a comfortable double-digit margin. Sharon Karungi led all scorers with 21 points, but YSU's Heidi Schlegel put up an impressive 19-point, 19-rebound evening. Though she shot just 4-of-16 from the field, Schlegel was 10 -for- 11 from the foul line. Freshman Aliyah Isaac contributed nine points in seven minutes off the bench.

Head Coach Tracey Dorow: Tracey Dorow (13-32) is in her second season at the helm of the Valparaiso women's basketball program in 2013-14. In her first season, Dorow led the Crusaders to eleven victories overall, including five in Horizon League play. Dorow arrived in Valparaiso after 14 seasons at Ferris State. She compiled a 232-163 record while with the Bulldogs. Furthermore, Ferris State posted the \#1 grade point average in all of Division II for the 19992000 women's basketball season as well as the \#2 ranking in 2002-2003.

Series Notes: Dating back to the days of their Mid-Con duels, Oakland leads the all-time series 13-9 versus Valparaiso. Wednesday night's contest will be the first meeting between these two teams since Feb. 10th, 2007. While the Golden Grizzlies have won three straight over Valpo, the Crusaders have won three of the last four matchups at the Athletics Center O'Rena.

## Storylines...

- 2,531 days have passed since the former Mid-Con rivals have duked it out on the court.
- Valpo and Oakland met in the Mid-Con Conference Tourney in four straight seasons (2000-2003).
-Elizabeth Hamlet makes her return to Rochester. The fifth-year senior graduated from Oakland last year and is seeking a graduate degree at Valpo.
- The Crusaders are looking for a win in their HL road opener for the first time since the 2007-08 season.
- Oakland's Olivia Nash and Valpo's Sharon Karungi are tied for third in the league with five double-doubles each.
- Of the 15 players on Oakland's roster, 13 hail from Michigan.


## @OaklandWBB

- @OaklandWBB is the only HL team to score 100 points in a game this season.
- @ OaklandWBB leads the Horizon League in blocked shots with 48 and is averaging a shade under 10 steals per contest.
-@ OaklandWBB forward Bethany Watterworth leads the HL in field goal percentage at . 519 (56-for-108).
-Six of @ OaklandWBB's nine losses have come to Indiana, UCF, \#3
Tennessee, Temple Michigan State, and Minnesota (combined 66-28).
- Olivia Nash is @ OaklandWBB’s leading scorer (12.8 PPG).
- Two other Golden Grizzlies are averaging double digits (Elena Popkey,
12.2 PPG, Watterworth, 10.8 PPG) and Kim Bee possesses a 9.9 average.
- @ OaklandWBB is shooting just $28.9 \%$ from three-point range.
- Jeff Tungate is in his first season as head coach of the Golden Grizzlies.
- Tungate was associate head coach of the men's team at Oakland for six years before being named the women's head coach on 7/16/13.


## Jessica Carr

- Scored 12 points and had four assists in just her second game of the season.
- Made her season debut versus Western Michigan on Dec. 29th, where she scored five points and notched an assist, steal, and rebound.


## Elizabeth Hamlet

- Shot 3-for-5 from the field in Valpo's 63-61 defeat of Toledo at the Toledo Invite.


## Abby Dean

- Has made 17 of her last 18 free-throw attempts.
- Leads the Horizon League in free-throw percentage (91.4\%).
- Has knocked down five field goals in five different contests.
- Compiled 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, and 17-point games.
- Has started every game for the Crusaders.
- Registered a career-high 17 points at Tennessee Tech on 11/24/13. - Scored first collegiate points at Cameron Indoor Stadium on 11/23/12.
- Made collegiate debut on November 14th versus Purdue-Calumet.
- Tossed in 11 points in 19 minutes vs.Western Michigan last season.


## Lexi Miller

- Has missed last four games as she recovers from a concussion.
- Tallied 13 assists to five turnovers during the Toledo Invite.
- Scored a career-high 18 points vs. Tennessee Tech.
- Owns best assists/turnover ratio of any Crusader (29:28).
- Accumulated 15 points, four rebounds, four assists, and three steals (all career highs at the time) at Saint Louis on 11/10/13.
- Made collegiate debut against the Indiana Hoosiers 11/9/12.
- Made first start in Hinkle Fieldhouse versus the Butler Bulldogs.
- Scored 13 points in Valpo's 88-62 victory over UIC on 2/16/13.


## Charae Richardson

- Has scored 13 or more points in six of team's 14 games.
- Scored a career-high 23 points versus Montana State.
- Dished out a season-high seven assists at Tennessee Tech.
- Leads team in points/game (11.7) and total assists (39).
- Scored 15 points in the season opener at Saint Louis on Nov. 10th.

- Carried an 84.1 free-throw percentage.

## Liz Horton

## Tracey Dorow <br> Head Coach <br> 2nd Season <br> 245-195 overall, 13-32 at Valpo Western Michigan, 1996

Tracey Dorow was named head coach of the Valparaiso women's basketball program in April of 2012.
Dorow arrived at Valpo after spending 14 seasons as the head coach at Ferris State University, guiding the Bulldogs to four NCAA Division II Tournament appearances, two Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) North Division championships, and four 20-win seasons.

In her 14 seasons at Ferris State, Dorow compiled a 232-163 (.587) record, including a 23-7 mark in 2011-2012 while guiding the Bulldogs to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. The all-time winningest coach in FSU history, she led her squad to the Sweet Sixteen in 2007.

The GLIAC Coach of the Year in 2003-2004, Dorow had five players earn a total of seven All-American honors and had seven players tally 10 total All-Region Team accolades. Her student-athletes earned All-GLIAC honors 22 times and 10 times she had players represented on the GLIAC All-Defensive Team. Under Dorow's guidance, Ferris State produced the GLIAC Player of the Year in 2000-2001, and she twice coached the GLIAC Freshman of the Year.

Dorow's student-athletes also excelled in the classroom, as three times she has led a First Team Academic All-American and 14 times her players have earned Academic All-District honors. A total of 45 different players earned GLIAC All-Academic recognition during her time at Ferris State. Ferris State posted the No. 1 grade point average in the country in Division II for the 1999-2000 women's basketball season, and her team ranked second in the nation in 2002-2003.

Dorow began her coaching career as an assistant coach at Lake Michigan Community College in Benton Harbor, Mich. where she helped lead the Indians to a 69-22 record in three seasons, winning two Western Collegiate Conference titles. Lake Michigan finished fourth in the 1997 NJCAA national tournament and held a No. 1 national ranking in February of that same season. She also spent one season as a graduate assistant at the University of Indianapolis.

A collegiate player at Illinois State from 1990-1993, she led the Redbirds in assists as a sophomore while finishing seventh in the Gateway Conference that same season. After transferring to Northern Michigan University for the 1993-1994 season, she earned Newcomer of the Year and Best Defensive Player honors for the Wildcats. Dorow had 131 assists and made 54 threes at NMU in her one season there. As a prep player, she finished third in the state of Michigan for Miss Basketball in 1990 and was named to the Detroit Free Press All-Decade Team.

Dorow earned her Bachelor of Science degree in education from Western Michigan University in 1996 and her Master of Arts degree from the University of Indianapolis in 2003 in curriculum and instruction. She married her husband, Rob, in August of 2007. The Dorow's have two children: Lainie, 4, and Baxter, 2, who are both incredibly proud to be Crusaders.
