Next Up in Crusader Basketball: The Crusaders begin a five-game road trip Sunday that takes them to Tennessee, Florida, and Ohio. Valpo will take on the Golden Eagles of Tennessee Tech Sunday afternoon before heading to Miami for the week of Thanksgiving. The Brown and Gold will log 3,080 travel miles before playing its next home game.

Last Time Out: Valpo held its home opener Thursday night against a team it historically has had success against in the past. However, IUPUI took advantage of a quality, deep bench as the Jaguars handed the Crusaders an 84-51 loss. Thursday represented just the second time IUPUI has recorded a win at the ARC since the series began in 1980.

Head Coach Tracey Dorow: Tracey Dorow (11-24) is in her second season at the helm of the Valparaiso women's basketball program in 2013-14. In her first season, Dorow led the Crusaders to eleven victories overall, including five in Horizon League play. Dorow arrived in Valparaiso after 14 seasons at Ferris State. She compiled a 232-163 record while with the Bulldogs. Furthermore, Ferris State posted the #1 grade point average in all of Division II for the 1999-2000 women's basketball season as well as the #2 ranking in 2002-2003.

Series Notes: Sunday will be the first ever meeting on the hardwood between Valparaiso and Tennessee Tech. The Crusaders are 4-2 all-time versus teams from Tennessee. This is Valpo's first trip to the Volunteer State in over 10 years. The Brown and Gold's last game in the state of Tennessee was on January 6th, 2003 when they lost a 57-56 heartbreaker to Lipscomb. That season eventually saw the Crusaders win the Mid-Con Tournament and make an appearance in the NCAA Tournament.

- Valpo embarks on a five-game road trip beginning Sunday in Tennessee.
- Thursday's loss was only the Crusaders' third in their last nine home openers.
- It's been feast or famine for the Golden Eagles: none of their first three games have been decided by fewer than 45 points.
- Tennessee Tech will head to Las Vegas after its game with the Crusaders, as the Golden Eagles will play in the South Point Thanksgiving Classic.
- Valpo, on the other hand, will jet to Miami to prepare for the FIU Thanksgiving Classic.
- The Golden Eagles won 19 games last season before losing in the OVC Tournament Championship Game to UT-Martin.

- Davis was also named the ACC Coach of the Year in 1990 and 1994.
- Davis is the all-time winningest coach (men or women) in Clemson

history.

Abby Dean

- Owns the team lead in total points scored so far this season (38).
- Has missed just once on 11 attempts from the free-throw line.
- Registered a career-high 13 points at Illinois on Nov. 12th, 2013.
- Scored first collegiate points at historic Cameron Indoor Stadium last November.
- Made collegiate debut on November 14th versus Purdue-Calumet
- Tossed in 11 points versus Western Michigan in 19 minutes last December.

Lexi Miller

- Has registered more assists than turnovers (10:9)
- Tied for team lead in steals (8).
- Accumulated 15 points, four rebounds, four assists, and three steals (all career highs) at Saint Louis on Nov. 10th, 2013.
- Made collegiate debut against the Indiana Hoosiers Nov, 9th, 2012.
- Made first start in Hinkle Fieldhouse versus the Butler Bulldogs.
- Scored 13 points in Valpo's 88-62 victory over UIC on Feb. 16th, 2013.

Charae Richardson

- Ranks 3rd in the Horizon League in FT% (86.4)

Tracey Dorow

Head Coach 2nd Season 243-187 overall, 11-24 at Valpo Western Michigan, 1996

Tracey Dorow was named head coach of the Valparaiso women's basketball program in April of 2012.

Dorow arrived at Valpo after spending 14 seasons as the head coach at Ferris State University, guiding the Bulldogs to four NCAA Division II Tournament appearances, two Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) North Division championships, and four 20-win seasons.

In her 14 seasons at Ferris State, Dorow compiled a 232-163 (.587) record, including a 23-7 mark in 2011-2012 while guiding the Bulldogs to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. The all-time winningest coach in FSU history, she led her squad to the Sweet Sixteen in 2007.

The GLIAC Coach of the Year in 2003-2004, Dorow had five players earn a total of seven All-American honors and had seven players tally 10 total All-Region Team accolades. Her student-athletes earned All-GLIAC honors 22 times and 10 times she had players represented on the GLIAC All-Defensive Team. Under Dorow's guidance, Ferris State produced the GLIAC Player of the Year in 2000-2001, and she twice coached the GLIAC Freshman of the Year.

Dorow's student-athletes also excelled in the classroom, as three times she has led a First Team Academic All-American and 14 times her players have earned Academic All-District honors. A total of 45 different players earned GLIAC All-Academic recognition during her time at Ferris State. Ferris State posted the No. 1 grade point average in the country in Division II for the 1999-2000 women's basketball season, and her team ranked second in the nation in 2002-2003.

Dorow began her coaching career as an assistant coach at Lake Michigan Community College in Benton Harbor, Mich. where she helped lead the Indians to a 69-22 record in three seasons, winning two Western Collegiate Conference titles. Lake Michigan finished fourth in the 1997 NJCAA national tournament and held a No. 1 national ranking in February of that same season. She also spent one season as a graduate assistant at the University of Indianapolis.

A collegiate player at Illinois State from 1990-1993, she led the Redbirds in assists as a sophomore while finishing seventh in the Gateway Conference that same season. After transferring to Northern Michigan University for the 1993-1994 season, she earned Newcomer of the Year and Best Defensive Player honors for the Wildcats. Dorow had 131 assists and made 54 threes at NMU in her one season there. As a prep player, she finished third in the state of Michigan for Miss Basketball in 1990 and was named to the Detroit Free Press All-Decade Team.

Dorow earned her Bachelor of Science degree in education from Western Michigan University in 1996 and her Master of Arts degree from the University of Indianapolis in 2003 in curriculum and instruction. She married her husband, Rob, in August of 2007. The Dorow's have two children: Lainie, 4, and Baxter, 2, who are both incredibly proud to be Crusaders.



to knocking down a trey versus Purdue-Calumet (Nov. 14)...pulled down two boards and sunk a free throw at Butler (Nov. 19)...nailed a three-pointer and hauled in three rebounds in her first start of the season at Cameron Indoor Stadium versus #4 Duke (Nov. 23)...recorded an assist and a steal in a start at Western Illinois (Nov. 27)...made a three-pointer and had two assists at Louisville (Dec. 8)...went 2-for-3 from three-point land and recorded a steal at Michigan (Dec. 20)...tallied five points, five boards, and four assists in 27 minutes versus Youngstown State (Jan. 12)...scored nine points on 3-of-6 shooting versus Green Bay (Jan. 26)...converted on her only three-point attempt at Wright State as part of a five-point game (Jan. 31)...accumulated a season-high five assists against Cleveland State (Feb. 2)...was 2-for-2 from the field at Detroit (Feb. 9)...brought down six boards and went 6-for-6 from the charity stripe versus UIC (Feb. 16)...scored eight points and had four assists against Milwaukee (Feb. 21)...started the final six games of the season, averaging 7.5 points in those tilts...recorded a season-high 14 points versus UIC in the Horizon League Conference Tournament while logging a season-high 33 minutes (Mar. 11)...tallied eight points and five rebounds in the season finale at #20 Green Bay (Mar. 13).

2011-2012: Appeared in 28 games and made four starts as a freshman ... most games played on the season among Valpo freshman ... averaged four points per game ... amassed 20 three-point field goals, the third highest total among Crusaders ... finished second on the team with 58 assists ... played 16 minutes in collegiate debut on Nov. 22 versus Western Illinois ... scored first collegiate points with five-point effort at Colorado (Nov. 25) ... earned first career start against Montana State (Nov. 26) ... set new career highs in points (7), steals (4) and assists (6) against Indiana Northwest (Nov. 30) ... posted first double-digit point total, surpassing personal best with 10 points in 26 minutes at Pittsburgh (Dec. 10) ... scored season-high 12 points on 3-of-5 shooting in win at Ball State (Dec. 18) ... added eight points and two steals in first career Horizon League game against Wright State (Dec. 28) ... tallied a career-high three treys in an 11-point effort at Detroit (Dec. 31) ... grabbed a career-high five rebounds and played all 40 minutes in first career Horizon League start at home versus Youngstown State (Jan. 7) ... earned starting assignment and scored three points against Butler (Jan. 14) ... dished out four assists against Milwaukee (Jan. 26) ... started and scored eight points versus UIC (Feb. 16) ... eight-point, five-assist game off the bench against Loyola (Feb. 18) ... scored seven points versus Wright State (March 1) ... appeared in both the first round and quarterfinal games of the Horizon League Championships ... scored two points against No. 10 Green Bay (March 7).




