Touchdown	6 points
PAT Kick	1 point
PAT Run or Pass	2 points
Field Goal	3 points
3 Consecutive First Downs	3 points
Explosive Run (10+ yards)	3 points
Explosive Pass (15+ yards)	3 points

Defensive points are as follows:

Touchdown	6 points
Force a Turnover	6 points
4 <sup>th</sup> Down stop	4 points
3-and-out to start drive	4 points
3-and-out after 1 first down	3 points
Safety	2 points
Sack	2 points
Sudden Change	4 points

(offense gets ball inside 35 yard line and does not score or is held to field goal)
