REGULAR SEASON: The Washington Wild Things, in their 20th season of Frontier League baseball, amassed 62 wins, the second best win total in REGULAR SEASON: The Washington with Things, in their 20th Season of The Head go de below) as an organization. The Wild Things won the 8th division title in franchise history, capturing the West Division crown officially Tuesday, August 30 after taking over first-place and never falling back again June 21. Shortstop Nick Ward finished third in the league in BA (3rd), first in OBP (.478), fifth in SE (6.820), fifth in BB (5th) and one of 15 players in the league with 19 or more home runs (19). Wagner Lagrange finished sixth in doubles (27). Anthony Brocato, who hit two home runs with the Wild Things after a trade from Florence, finished with 24 home runs, a total tied for sixth in the league. He also finished with 78 RBI (10 in 10 games with the Wild Things). Rob Whalen finished tied for first in the league in wins with 12 after missing three weeks and was 8th in ERA (3.50). Sandro Cabrera was 7th in ERA at 3.42. Lukas Young finished tied for 2nd in saves with 20. As a team, Washington finished fourth in BA (.284), third in OBP (.371) and fifth in SLG (.441). On the mound, Washington was tied for fourth in ERA (4.08). In the field, Washington was second in fewest errors made (.68) and highest fielding percentage (.981). The club set a new team single-season record for doubles with 168. Individually, Wagner Lagrange matched the single-season hits record with 125 (Lance Keenig, 125, 2005), Nobe Foster set the new single-season ERA record at 1.00 (passing Zack Strecker's 1.29 in 2019). Hector Roa became the franchise's HR king. Nick Ward's .478 OBP is the new single-season OBP record for Washington and he has the new OPS record as well at 1.098.

JOURNEY TO 1,000 VICTORIES: Washington won its 1,000th game Friday, August 12 in the series opener against the Gateway Grizlies in Sauget, Illinois, The win, a 6-4 victory, made the Wild Things the fourth team joining Evansville (in 27th season), Windy City (in 23rd season) and River City (Rascals, played 21 seasons and left the league after 2019) in the 1,000-win club in the Frontier League. Washington is the fastest team to the mark in league history.

SKIPPER'S MILESTONE AND HONDR: Tom Vaeth owns 118 wins in the regular season as skipper of the Wild Things. Vaeth reached the 100 wins milestone on August 3, becoming the third fastest Wild Things' manager to the mark, behind John Massarelli and Jeff Isom. Massarelli is Washington's all-time winningest manager and Isom was 100-62 in his two seasons managing the club (2002-03). The win tied Vaeth for third on the list as he now chases Gregg Langbehn, who won 190 games. His 101st win secured him third. Tom was also selected as the 2022 Roger Hanners Award Winner in the Frontier League for Manager of the Year in his second season as manager of the Wild Things. He's led Washington to two division titles and the club made the Frontier League Championship Series in his first season.

JACOB DEMPSEY INDUCTED INTO FL HALL: Jacob Dempsey entered the Frontier League Hall of Fame July 20 in a pre-game ceremony prior to the ASG. Dempsey was a tremendous RBI man for Washington from 2008-2010. In his 257 games, he had 221 RBI. Almost half of his 264 hits went for extra bases. He was named to the FL PS All-Star team as the DH in both 2008 and 2009.

FRANCHISE RECORD NINE REPRESENT WASHINGTON IN ASG: Nine Wild Things played on the West Division All-Star Team this season, which set a new franchise record, surpassing the previous mark of eight set in 2018 when the ASG was Rookies vs Experienced in River City (D'Fallon, MO). SS Nick Ward and OF Wagner Lagrange were voted in as starters and ended up being joined by RHP Rob Whalen (manager's choice) and 1B Andrew Czech (injury replacement) in teh lineup. Czech and Whalen had already been voted in as pitcher and resevre, along with Lukas Young as a pitcher and lan Walters, Alex Alvarez, Scotty Dubrule (manager's addition) and Cole Brannen (injury replacement) as reserves. Tom Vaeth and Alex Boshers were on the West staff while Austin Pascarella served as the West athletic trainer for the event, hosted by the Wild Things.

WILD THINGS RECEIVE FOUR FRONTIER LEAGUE POSTSEASON AWARDS: For the fourth time in club history, the Washington Wild Things have been named the Frontier League Organization of the Year. The team saw success with events, promotions, programs, on the field and off. Manager Tom Vaeth has been named the Manager of the Year, LHP Kobe Foster is the Rookie of the Year and SS Nick Ward was named to the post-season All-Star team as the shortston.



Rookie: Each club must carry a minimum of 10 rookies (combined R1 and R2 -- R1's are in their pro debut seasons or XP that doesn't meet the requirements for a full season (75 at bats, 15 games pitched or 30 innings pitched)... R2's are in their second pro season by those qualifications

**Experienced:** Each Club can carry a max of 14 Es/VETs (no more than four can be veterans) -- E's are in at least their third season... The Veteran classification is for a player over 29 years of age prior to October 1 of that playing season... for the 2022 season, any player born on or before 9/30/93 is a VET no matter their playing experience in pro ball

21-Year Old Exemption: Any player who is 21 years of age or younger on or after October 1 of any season and is entering his first year in the league, regardless of any other playing experience in pro ball, will be considered no higher than an R-2

Military Exemption: Players who served on active military duty will receive an exemption to the age limit to avoid veteran status of one year for each year of active duty Position Change Exemption: Starting with 2016, position players who are switching to pitching and pitchers switching to a position will have their classifications reset to R2 provided they do not appear in any games at their previous position

Injured List Limits: Teams can have a maximum of one player on the 7-Day IL and two on the 14-Day IL. There is no limit on players to the 60-Day IL Inactive List: Players must be on the inactive list for a minimum of 14 days before they can be activated
